Looking Back and Planning Ahead

As we close the door on 2021, we reflect, review, celebrate, and learn so we can improve our care and service in 2022 and beyond. We are honored to provide access to affordable, comprehensive, patient-centered, primary medical, behavioral, and dental care to our community every day.

COVID testing and vaccination outreach was one of the priorities. Between January and May, our team quickly set up a testing site in Clifton and then a drive-thru vaccine site in the Central High School parking lot. **We responded to outreach requests to help our farmworkers with testing and vaccines as well as our partners serving the homeless.**

Visits to the Warrior Wellness Center at Central HS really took off in 2021 with increasingly more students choosing to come to the Center for care each semester. The Care Team saw more students in Spring 2021, and decided to stay open on a limited schedule during the summer to offer sports physicals. By Fall semester, it seems that the word was out as even more students came seeking medical, dental and behavior healthcare. Student visits to the WWC between August and December of 2021 surpassed the numbers for all of 2020: 1,690 during five months compared to 1,095 during school year 2021.

The most significant challenge we faced, and continue to face, is recruitment and retention of staff. The "Great Resignation", being felt by industries everywhere, has effected our health center as well. For some employees, the risk of COVID exposure was concerning and for others, day care challenges were the tipping point. We continue to recruit for medical and behavioral health providers, medical and dental assistants, and nurses. One of the goals for our 2022-2024 Strategic Plan is the focus on becoming a "Health Center of Excellence" by developing and sustaining a service culture of excellence both as a health care provider and employer. This goal energizes us.

Overall, medical and dental visits are back to pre-pandemic numbers. Patients are happy to come back in to the clinic to see their medical or dental provider. The 2021 year ended with over 11,000 unduplicated patients being served with 40,000 visits.

Spotlight: Western Colorado **Community Foundation Supports Marillac**

If you are not familiar with the Western Colorado Community Foundation (WCCF), you should know that over the last 25 years, WCCF has taken a leadership role in addressing community needs, not only in our county, but in six other counties on the Western Slope as well.

Marillac has benefitted from WCCF's mission and commitment since 2004, which is when we received our first donation: \$200 for general operations. Since then, we have received funding through donor advised funds, the substantial ongoing gift from the Waldeck Endowment Fund, and competitive grants for - among other things - substance abuse and prevention, dental screenings, supplies, and general operations.

Late in 2021 WCCF contacted us to say they had a donor who, when he passed, indicated he wanted his residual monies to help support kids who need help affording adequate medical care. Since WCCF has been a strong and early supporter of Marillac's school-based health center at Central High School, Marillac gladly suggested that the \$10,000 gift be directed to student healthcare there. WCCF has our community's health in mind, and we are grateful for their partnership.
