What is Integrated Care and Why Do We Care?

There are many things about MarillacHealth that make it unique and different from all other offices that provide primary health care in Mesa County, but two items rise to the top.

#1: We cannot and do not turn anyone away seeking health care at Marillac. In fact, we care for everyone of any age, gender, ethnicity, and race, no matter how much money they make or if they have insurance or not. #2: We follow a philosophy and care model called Integrated Care.

Reason #1 encourages patient use of the clinic by reducing financial barriers, the number one reason people do not get health care, Marillac offers a Sliding Fee Discount Program which makes care affordable while giving patients a sense of investment in their health and health care.

Reason #2 is the method by which people become healthy once cared for by our health professionals.

At Marillac, integration happens between what we traditionally think of as separate service lines -- medical, dental, and mental health -- and in the delivery of care at the patient level. There is active and intentional coordination of care around the needs of our patients that takes place during daily Care Team huddles, where individual patient care is assessed, discussed, and planned. Interdisciplinary Teams address all health indicators and needs including diabetes, cardiovascular disease, cancer screenings, pre- and perinatal care, child health, oral health, and behavioral health, to name a few. Care may include in-clinic care and/or outside referrals to a specialist partner.

Our patients are pleasantly surprised to be told that, as a Marillac patient, they will have access not only to medical care, but to dental and behavioral health care as well. And even when they hear it, it doesn't become real until they experience it.

Since health is influenced by many external factors that we think of as more socially induced, **treatment plans must include consideration of social determinants of health (SDoH) which are those physical, geographical, cultural, or financial barriers that can inhibit access to and engagement in care.** SDoH's are strong predictors of poor health outcomes, which is why Marillac staff and Care Teams include Patient Navigators, Eligibility Assistants, and Case Managers who, with the patient's consent, aid with financials, transportation, housing, food, clothing, job training, and other resources.

The attention that comes when a dentist connects a patient with a BH Specialist because of their expressed anxiety, or a PA brings in a Case Manager to meet with a patient who hasn't had heat in their home all month, helps build trust between the patient and caregiver, which can lead to good health and independence.

It is the integration of systems and caring individuals that makes Marillac unique in its ability to meet the needs of our community of patients who are our neighbors, our community.

Moving with Care Into Montrose

On January 1, 2024, Marillac legally acquired The PIC Place, a non-profit health clinic that has served the people of Montrose and surrounding communities since 2002 providing primary medical, behavioral, dental, and optical health care. Like Marillac, PIC began as a grassroots organization to serve vulnerable people who struggled to obtain and afford health care. PIC realized that becoming aligned with a Federally Qualified Health Center (FQHC) was a necessary step to sustain, maintain, and grow their care for patients. PIC is now officially a Marillac care site, with all its 33 professional and capable employees. And the best part of all is that 3,400 persons residing in Montrose and Delta counties will continue to receive high quality, affordable health care close to home with a few added benefits that Marillac brings with its FQHC designation.
