Digging in the Dirt

We're in the ground! Finally, after many months of planning, designing, permitting, and budgeting, the dirt's a-flyin'. At first it was ceremonial, as nearly 100 supporters came out to celebrate the moment, watching as Marillac staff and board members donned hard hats and grabbed shovels to fling the first bits of dirt. And now, FCI Constructors and subcontractors are doing the real digging. Our new home is officially a construction site!

Some interesting facts:

- There are usually 18-20 crew members on-site every day
- Donut deliveries: 1 so far (and we didn't even take any out of the box before handing them over!)
- Toilets: 2 so far
- 60-70% of the subcontractors on this project are from the Western Slope
- We're under budget so far!
- Our new building will have nearly half a mile of piping for electrical (3,000 feet) and 1,830 feet for plumbing!



Voter Registration at Marillac

Marillac joins many other health centers around the country and state to support non-partisan voter registration efforts "...as a means of reducing barriers to civic engagement within the communities they serve." (HRSA Guidelines) It has been shown that communities with greater levels of civic participation are healthier. Because Marillac is all about helping people who might experience barriers to accessing registration opportunities, we make this opportunity available to patients and staff.

Marillac has partnered with the Community Resource Center and Mesa County Public Health to host a table for a couple of hours each Monday in the MCPH lobby, between August and late October. CRC staff can help someone check their registration status, show them how to update their mailing address, answer questions about key dates, and help them through the registration process if they need it.

Patients interest in dental cleanings is so strong that Marillac made a request to Western Colorado Community Foundation to support the purchase of equipment and instruments to allow the clinic to provide this service. Marillac Once Again Receives Prestigious Quality Designations

Earlier this month, the nation's Health Resources & Services Administration announced various 2024 quality designations in the areas of Access, Quality, Health Equity, and Health Information Technology, with Marillac again earning four awards:

Access Enhancer—patient population expansion from 9,800 patients in 2022 to 13,512 patients in 2023

Health Disparities Reducer—improvement in health outcomes in at least two areas for one or more racial or ethnic groups

Advancing Heath Information Technology—utilizing technology in delivery of healthcare

Addressing Social Risk Factors—gathering information from patients to help support better health outcomes

Marillac Secures Funding to Expand Care for Patients with Mental Health Needs Substance Use Disorder

We can finally stop holding our breath and cheer: the Health Resources & Services Administration (HRSA) has awarded \$1.1 million (\$600,000 of which falls into Year 1) to expand our behavioral health and substance use disorder treatments to all patients across our seven locations! Why were we holding our breath? Marillac was competing with many other Federally Qualified Health Centers across the country for a total \$240 million in funds that were being made available to only 400 organizations.

This funding will have a significant impact on the people in our region who seek this care: it allows us to expand our clinical mental health and treatment workforce and increase our capacity to screen, treat, and support the recovery of persons impacted by substance use. For our community, this means Marillac will provide patient-centered, culturally humble care that is appropriate for persons of all ages, cultures, and lifestyles.
